Substantive content: the subject of the course in commercial law will be to introduce students to the basic concepts of commercial law in Poland, and then to make comparative legal studies with the legal systems of students' countries of origin

CLASSES: the concept of commercial law, commercial law versus company law – general description, entrepreneur, business activity and enterprise, business name and representation of an entrepreneur, central register and information on economic activity (CEIDG).

LECTURES: register of entrepreneurs – national court register, partnership under commercial law, property and internal relations in partnerships, general aspects of capital companies, structure of assets and the bodies of capital companies

Learning purpose: learning about the basic issues of commercial law
